FROM CAVE HILL CEMETERY'S PRESIDENT & CEO



Beauty can be found at Cave Hill Cemetery in every season of the year. As the winter snows melt, and signs of spring begin to appear, we are reminded of how blessed we are to have such a beautiful place to memorialize and remember our loved ones. Following are some highlights of what the Cave Hill Heritage Foundation, with your support, has accomplished in the past year to achieve our mission to “Preserve the Past for the Future”.

Restoration of historical structures and monument art is a pillar of the Foundation’s mission. This past year approximately 260 markers and monuments were cleaned and/or repaired, and craftspeople have continued work on maintenance and restoration of the beautiful Satterwhite memorial.

The Foundation has committed to participating in the New York-based Bridge to Crafts Careers Program in collaboration with the World Monuments Fund and work began on this project in 2021. The program offers underrepresented youth in the Louisville area hands-on technical training with the opportunity for a stable career. Through some significant grants, the Foundation will facilitate the training of area young people as they work together to restore monuments within the cemetery.

Preservation of Cave Hill’s arbicultural setting is an important part of the Foundation’s work. A professional consultant has recently completed an inventory of Cave Hill’s trees listing 7,559 trees within the Cemetery representing 549 unique species. Cataloging this amazing collection of trees is an important step toward the cemetery’s goal of becoming an accredited Level III arboretum by ArbNet – which would make Cave Hill one of only 42 Level III arboreta globally!

Community education and awareness are central to the mission of the Foundation. This past year we have conducted numerous cemetery tours and lectures focusing on history, the Civil War, literary figures, and notable women buried at Cave Hill. We have also partnered with organizations such as The Filson Historical Society, Waterfront Botanical Gardens, Frazier History Museum, and Trees Louisville in an effort to provide stimulating educational experiences throughout the community. We hope you will participate in some of the many events planned for 2022.



RESTORATION



Restoration is at the heart of the Cave Hill Heritage Foundation mission and vision. As an outdoor art museum and repository of our city's history, our restoration efforts focus on the recovery and revival of Cave Hill's historic structures and monument art. The Cave Hill Heritage Foundation engages the practice of historic stone masonry restoration on many of the monuments and markers that dot the landscape. Specifically, this work is reserved for those lots where there is no means for easy communication with lot holders or their descendants. In 2021, our teams were very fortunate to focus attention on several sections within the oldest areas of Cave Hill Cemetery.






PRESERVATION

The preservation of Cave Hill Cemetery’s wonderful urban arboretum is a critical focus of our organizational vision. The Cave Hill Heritage Foundation acquires tree specimen appropriate for planting in the rural garden-style cemetery, identifies trees and plants through signage, and documents horticultural material. We produce horticultural-related publications and see opportunities to protect the environment by promoting the preservation of plants and trees within Cave Hill Cemetery. In 2021, we were able to successfully fulfill the preservation portion of our vision statement through the following projects.




EDUCATION




