



RESTORATION

As an outdoor art museum and repository for Louisville's history, the Cave Hill Heritage Foundation's restoration efforts focus on the recovery and revival of Cave Hill's historical structures and monumental art. We restore monuments and markers on cemetery lots when there is no means of communication with lot holders or their descendants, and acquire the services for masonry restoration as needed.



Inspired by the Temple of Love in Versailles, France, the Satterwhite Memorial underwent a full restoration by the Cave Hill Heritage Foundation in recent years.



PRESERVATION

The Cave Hill Heritage Foundation is focused on the long-term sustainability and care of the cemetery and the tree canopy it encompasses. We acquire tree specimen appropriate for the Cemetery, identify trees and plants through signage, and document horticultural material. We also produce horticultural-related publications and seek opportunities to protect the environment by promoting the preservation of plants and trees within Cave Hill Cemetery.



Community history tours are offered on a regular basis.

EDUCATION

Education and enrichment opportunities are integral to sharing the mission of the Cave Hill Heritage Foundation. We offer opportunities to study our community history, the Cemetery's environmental aspects, and best practices in monument restoration. Additionally, our *Walking Through Grief* programs offer support for families who have recently suffered a loss.
