Cave Hill is a place of unsurpassed beauty and peace for those of us who love nature and the outdoors. Cave Hill is a place for all who love history and learning. The three-fold mission of the Cave Hill Heritage Foundation is to restore and maintain historical monuments and buildings, preserve the arboretum setting, and provide community education and awareness. Following are some highlights of what the Cave Hill Heritage Foundation, with your support, has accomplished in the past year.

Cave Hill is featured as one of the *World’s Greatest Cemeteries* in a fabulous PBS series produced and hosted by Roberto Mighty. Roberto and his team visited Cave Hill and filmed Episode 1 of Season 2 of *World’s Greatest Cemeteries* which is available on KET at select times, on demand with KET Passport, and at the following website: www.pbs.org/show/worlds-greatest-cemeteries. Cave Hill shines in this series as truly one of the World’s Greatest Cemeteries and I encourage you to watch our episode, as well as view some of the other fascinating cemeteries that Roberto visits.

Restoration of historical structures and monument art is a pillar of the Foundation’s mission. This past year numerous markers and monuments were cleaned and/or repaired, and craftspeople have continued work on maintenance and restoration of the beautiful Satterwhite memorial.

In 2022, the Foundation participated in the New York-based Bridge to Crafts Careers Program in collaboration with World Monuments Fund. This program offers underrepresented youth hands-on technical training with the opportunity for a stable career. Interns completed a full restoration of the Spotts Mausoleum as well as numerous other projects throughout the cemetery.

Preservation of Cave Hill’s arboricultural setting is an important part of the Foundation’s work, and work continues toward the cemetery’s goal of becoming an accredited Level III arboretum by



ArbNet. This will make Cave Hill one of only 42 Level III arboreta globally!

Community education and awareness are central to the mission of the Foundation. This past year we conducted 36 public tours focusing on General History, Music History, Monument Symbolism, Military History, Bourbon History, Notable Women, and A Study of Benjamin Grove. We have also partnered with organizations such as The Filson Historical Society, Waterfront Botanical Gardens, Frazier History Museum, and Trees Louisville in an effort to provide stimulating educational experiences throughout the community. Now it is our turn to preserve and enhance this beautiful place. Created in 2005, the Cave Hill Heritage Foundation is a 501(c)3 non-profit organization that is dedicated to preserving the past for the future. We are an educational organization that is devoted to finding creative ways to immerse our community in history and nature by sharing information and offering learning experiences. The mission of the Cave Hill Heritage Foundation is three-fold:

RESTORATION of Monument Art & Historic Structures

PRESERVATION of the Arboretum Setting, and

EDUCATION and Enrichment Opportunities for the Community



RESTORATION

Restoration is at the heart of the Cave Hill Heritage Foundation mission and vision. As an outdoor art museum and repository of our city's history, our restoration efforts focus on the recovery and revival of Cave Hill's historic structures and monument art. The Cave Hill Heritage Foundation engages the practice of historic stonemasonry restoration on many of the monuments and markers that dot the landscape. Specifically, this work is reserved for those lots where there is no means for easy communication with lot holders or their descendants. In 2022, the Cave Hill Heritage Foundation and World Monuments Fund launched the Bridge to Crafts Careers Program. With over 1,600 hours of service, interns restored the historic Spotts Mausoleum, repointed the Satterwhite Mausoleum base, and cleaned over 160 markers and monuments. Our internal teams also continued to learn new skills and ensure the ongoing restoration of the Cemetery's oldest monuments.

PRESERVATION

The preservation of Cave Hill Cemetery's wonderful urban arboretum is a critical focus of our organizational vision. The Cave Hill Heritage Foundation acquires tree specimen appropriate for planting in the rural garden-style cemetery, identifies trees and plants through signage, and documents horticultural material. We produce horticultural-related publications and seek opportunities to protect the environment by promoting the preservation of plants and trees within Cave Hill Cemetery. In 2022, we were able to successfully fulfill the preservation portion of our vision statement through the following projects.



EDUCATION

In 2022, we were able to fulfill the education portion of our vision statement through the following projects.






