We acquire the services needed for masonry restoration and preserve public structures that are not under the auspices of Cave Hill Cemetery.

The Cave Hill Heritage Foundation acquires tree specimen appropriate for planting in the rural, garden-style cemetery, identifies trees and plants through signage, and documents horticultural material. We produce horticultural-related publications and seek opportunities to protect the environment by promoting the preservation of plants and trees within Cave Hill Cemetery.
